
Venue & Directions



This year we welcome Maya Irgalina who, while studying at the Royal Northern College of Music, has won the Ryzhard Bakst Memorial Chopin's Prize. She also became a prize-winner of the Dudley International Piano Competition, performing Mozart's Piano Concerto K595 with City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra conducted by Michael Seal.

The Aquinas Piano Trio is a new, exciting and ambitious chamber group. Ruth Rogers (violin) has worked as a duo with Martin Cousin (piano) for several years and has also played extensively with Katherine Jenkinson (cello) in the Iuventus Quartet. All three players are established solo artists in their own right and have vast experience of the chamber music repertoire. They came together to record the Thomas Hyde work 'Three Dancers' which was a Music at Duffield commission in 2005 and described as '...engaging, tonal and quirky, with the hint of a tango.' We are hoping to commission a companion piece to receive its first performance at this concert. The Trio have already played at the VoiceBox and Derby Chamber Music and received rave reviews.

Ben was a member of the National Youth Orchestra of Great Britain and more recently the European Union Youth Orchestra and has also worked with Orchestra Mozart, based in Bologna, Italy under the direction of Claudio Abbado.
